Please tell us what you will be selling/showing: (EAA 611 does not allow vendor competition sales. EAA 611 hosts the Cracker Fly-In event in order to raise money to support our chapter, education of aviation, Young Eagle flights, Eagle flights and more. We raise funds by selling breakfast and T-shirts. Vendors are not allowed to compete with EAA611 without prior authorization. No soliciting of donations outside of vendors booth space.)

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Vendors must submit and be approved no later than 14 days prior to the event. This allows our coordinators time to arrange the layout and our printer's time to print up the event programs.

Vendor spaces are available in 15x15 foot spaces. This is adequate enough for a 10x10 or 12x12 pop up tent. If larger spaces are needed, please contact us and we can accommodate if space is available.

Vendor spaces are rented first come; first serve for \$50 each 15x15 space.

Vendors must bring their own power and water. (Generators are allowed)

Vendors can NOT park their vehicles at or behind their assigned vendor spaces unless they are part of your booth (food truck or trailer). Parking will be in the general public lot.

Please bring appropriate advertising banners and signage so the public can see what you are selling.

A 25 ft section between vendors and the fence MUST be kept open for vehicle traffic and emergencies. (Vendor parking is not allowed against the fence – this area must remain open)

ALL vendors must be in place and setup by 8 am the day of the event. Vendors will not be allowed to drive out until the event is closed @ 3pm. This is a safety hazard for aircraft and the Sky Soldiers helicopters that are flying in and out. The Vendor traffic has to pass by the helicopters, so we shut down vendor lane at 8am. Emergencies are the only exception. If you plan to leave, please park your vehicle in the public parking lot.

All tents MUST be staked to the ground (aircraft create wind). We encourage leg-stakes vs ropes. You may also use weighted hold downs like bricks or water ballast. If you must use ropes and stake them to the ground, you MUST tag the ropes so there are no trip hazards.

Vendors are encouraged to advertise in our Cracker Fly-In Program. We hand these out to attendees so they know the locations of vendor booths and aircraft types. ½ Page ads in the program are available for \$50 and also include ad space on our chain link fence for banners (vendors provide their own banners) and ad space on our [www.crackerflyin.com](http://www.crackerflyin.com) website.
