



Vendor Rules

July 07, 2018

Hours of Operation: Saturday 7a.m. till 3p.m.

Vendors, we (EAA 611 Cracker Fly-In host) must follow many City, County and FAA rules and guidelines. In order for us to remain legal and safe, we ask that YOU – the vendor follow these rules.

Vendor applications must be completed and submitted. These can be found on our website.

Vendor spaces are in 15x15 foot spaces.

Vendors must bring their own power and water. (Generators are allowed)

Vendors can ONLY park 1 vehicle at or behind their assigned vendor space unless they are part of a food truck or trailer. All other vehicles must park in the general public lot – which is FREE.

A 25 ft section between vendors and the fence MUST be kept open for vehicle traffic and emergencies. (Vendor parking is not allowed against the fence – this area must remain open)!

Vendors will not be allowed to drive out until the event is closed @ 3pm. This is a safety hazard for all. Emergencies are the only exception. If you plan to leave, please park your vehicle in the public parking lot. This row is used for Emergency vehicles during the event.

ALL vendors must be in place and setup by 8 am the day of the event.

Please bring appropriate advertising banners and signage so the public can see what you are selling.

All tents MUST be staked to the ground (aircraft create wind). We encourage leg-stakes vs ropes. You may also use weighted hold downs like bricks or water ballast. If you must use ropes and stake them to the ground, you MUST tag the ropes so there are no trip hazards.

Vendor booths are limited to 6 persons for free admission. Any more than 6 MUST pay admission at the gate.
